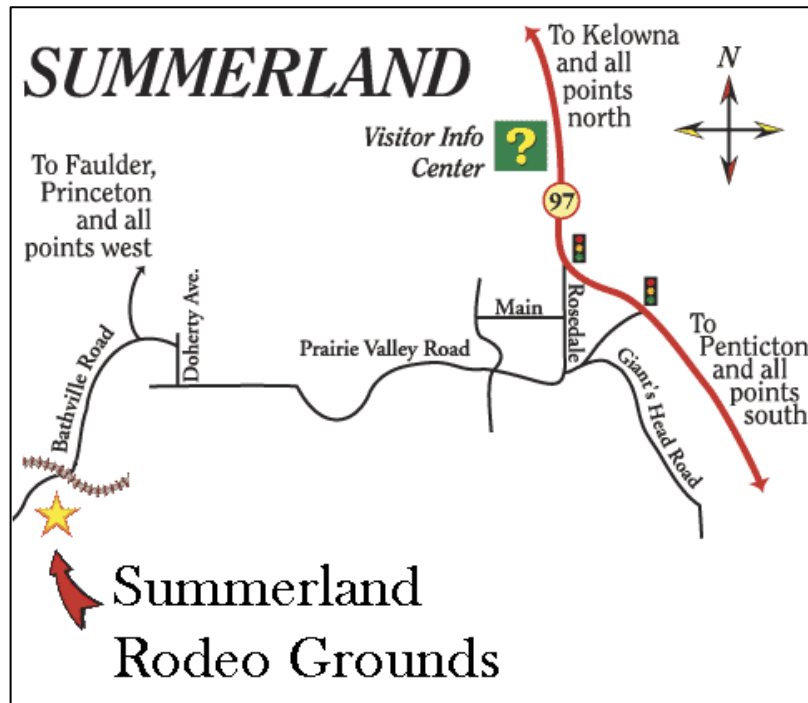


Who We Are

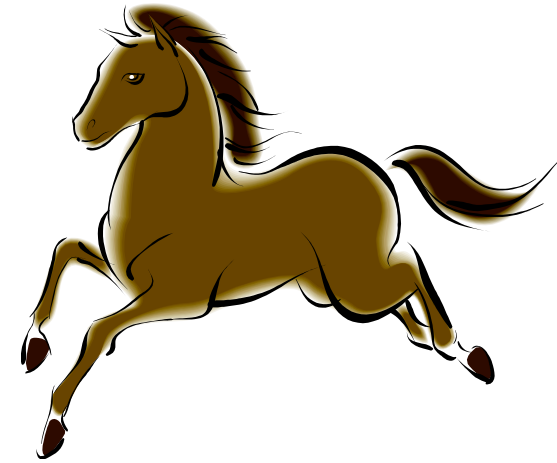

Rules

1. Current HCBC Rule Book for General Performance shall be in effect. A copy will be available in the Show Office, or download your own from <http://www.hcbc.ca/Competition.html>. Any discrepancy or vagueness in the HCBC rulebook, the judge will then defer to Equine Canada rules.
2. The show committee reserve the right to either divide or combine classes.
3. Inappropriate or unsafe attire or tack may be penalized at the discretion of the judge. Helmets mandatory for all Juniors (English and Western) and all Seniors in English. Special classes (Bareback Equitation and Bit-Less Pattern Class) require ALL RIDERS to wear a helmet, no exceptions.
4. Stallions MUST be ridden/handled by Senior competitors, and CANNOT be stabled overnight on the Grounds.
5. **AGE DIVISIONS:** Senior: 19 years and older as of January 1, 2010. Junior: 18 years and under as of January 1, 2010. Walk/Trot or Walk/Jog entries can only enter classes designated as such for that show day. EXCEPTIONS: Walk/Trot or Walk/Jog entries may also enter Showmanship and Halter classes. Walk/Jog classes may be ridden two-handed if using a snaffle bit (no shanks).
6. Protests or appeals must be made in writing, within 12 hours of the time of the cause of the protest, and submitted with a deposit of \$50 cash to the Show Secretary.
7. No refunds without a Veterinarian's Certificate.
8. **All dogs on leash and to be cleaned up after!** If you can't keep them leashed and clean up after them, leave them at home!
9. **OFFICIAL SHOW DAY PHOTOGRAPHY** provided by Okanagan Digital Photography. Visit their website: <http://www.canadarama.ca/events.htm>. John will be taking photos of everyone throughout the day. Prints up to 8 X 10 can be purchased on-site. Larger prints and plaque or canvas mounted prints can be viewed and ordered from John's trailer, or after the show online. He will also be available for posed shots of you, your horse and your ribbons at specific points during the day in photo area. J Look for his trailer both days of the show.

Class Descriptions *(more detailed descriptions available in the Rule Books)*

Bareback Equitation: Judged as an equitation class, just without your saddle! Helmets mandatory for ALL RIDERS no matter what age both English and Western.

Barrel Racing: Barrel racing is a timed event using three barrels raced in a clover-leaf pattern.

Bit-less Pattern Class: Judged on control and horsemanship. Use a halter, neck rope or nothing at all. Bonus points for least amount of tack and artificial aids (eg. bridle, saddle, spurs, whips, etc). Boots and helmet mandatory for ALL RIDERS both English and Western. Pattern to be posted.

Command Class: Commands are announced, and entries are eliminated one at a time as commands are not executed correctly, until only the winner remains.

Halter: Horses to be shown in hand and to be judged on their conformation and movement.

Hunter: To be judged on the horse's movement, manners, and way of going over fences. Horse and rider combination can only enter up to 2 consecutive Hunter classes (English: 26, 27, 28, 29, 30).

Hunter Hack: Entries judged on rail work and to jump two fences not exceeding 2'6".

Hunter Under Saddle: This class will be judged on performance, condition and conformation. Martingales not permitted, crop/whip allowed, breastplate optional.

Little Britches: For riders 12 & under, no cross entries. To walk and trot/jog only. Leadlines allowed.

Mismatched Pairs: Judged on how well the horses and riders maintain side-by-side position throughout the gaits as well as on how *mismatched* the pairs appear.

Pole Bending: Pole Bending is a timed event weaving a pattern through 6 poles.

Reining: The best reined horse should be wilfully guided or controlled with little or no apparent resistance. Pattern to be posted.

Road Hack: To be shown at a walk with a reasonably loose rein, trot, strong trot, easy canter and hand gallop. Horse to have smooth, ground-covering gaits.

Show Hack: Show hacks must have vitality, animation, presence, balance and clean fine limbs showing supreme quality.

Showmanship: Judged on performance and turnout of self and horse. Pattern to be posted.

Trail/Handy Horse: Judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles, with emphasis on manners, response of rider and quality of movement. Pattern to be posted.

Western and English Pleasure: Judged on the horse that is a pleasure to ride. May be asked to extend at any gait. Western riders to sit the extended jog. English to be judged on manners, performance, quality and conformation.

Western and Hunt Seat Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments and suitability of horse to rider.

Western Horsemanship: Judged on the rider's ability to execute both a pattern and rail work, with precision and smoothness while maintaining a correct body position.

Western Riding: A pattern class where the horse is judged on quality of gaits, lead changes at the lope, response to rider, manners and disposition. Pattern to be posted.
