Naked refers to the horse, of course! Riders must be clothed appropriately (formal attire is not required).

Helmets required for everyone!

Just like you're typical horse show... **just without the tack!** You can ride with as much or as little tack as you feel comfortable with, but why not try without a bit... or without a saddle... or without a bridle... how about without horse shoes?

Why a Naked Horse Show? We want to encourage a better relationship between horses and humans – and we want to show that all the extraneous metal and leather seen in the traditional show ring is NOT NECESSARY for horse and rider to communicate effectively.

“Disrobed” Dressage

To be ridden as either English or Western Dressage. Test callers allowed. Riders can enter up to 2 dressage tests, but there are limited spots available – register early!

1. Any HCBC 2010 Dressage Test, from Walk/Trot up to Level 2.
2. Any HCBC 2010 Dressage Test, from Walk/Trot up to Level 2.

**** Trail will be open from 8:30 to Noon ****

Mounted Trail “Au Natural”

To be ridden as either English Handy Horse or Western Trail.

3. Trail – Experienced
4. Trail – Beginner
5. Trail – Junior Beginner

On-Line Trail “Au Natural”

Horses to be lead or guided/directed through the Trail pattern, but must remain on-line. Bonus points for having a willing partner, and not having to drag your horse over/through obstacles!

6. Trail – On-line (non-mounted)

**** Classes from this point on will run consecutively ****

“Unbridled” Pleasure

To be ridden as either English Pleasure or Western Pleasure.

7. Pleasure – Experienced
8. Pleasure – Beginner
9. Pleasure – Junior Beginner

“Exposed” Equitation

To be ridden as either English Equitation or Western Equitation.

10. Equitation – Experienced
11. Equitation – Beginner
12. Equitation – Junior Beginner

Ride-A-Buck

Riders MUST ride bareback, with a “dollar bill” under their knee/thigh. Riders are eliminated as they lose their “dollar”.

Winner of each class splits the entry fees!

13. Command – Experienced
14. Command – Beginner
15. Command – Junior Beginner

Reining “in the Buff”

16. Reining – Walk/Trot
17. Reining – NHRA Pattern 6

**** BREAK TO SET UP JUMPS ****

Jumping “in the Nude”

18. Jumper – Cross-poles
(Leadlines allowed)
19. Jumper – 2’3”

***Note:** Class names are for humorous purposes only and do not designate what amount of tack is required. (i.e. You CAN enter Pleasure with a bridle.)

General Rules

- Neither SRG EDC, its staff, employees, volunteers or show committee will be held responsible in any way, for damage, injury, loss of persons, horses, or property belonging to spectators or exhibitors.
- Show committee reserves the right to split/cancel/combine classes as necessary.
- Show numbers MUST be worn and visible at all times during the show.
- Dogs must be on leash and kids must be under control! ☺
- HCBC 2010 Rule Book in effect. See “Tack and Attire” below for exceptions rules.

Tack and Attire

- **Helmets required for everyone – ALL AGES!**
- HCBC rule book will be referenced for all tack RESTRICTIONS, but not requirements. (i.e. you are restricted from using twisted wire bits – but you are not required to use bit at all). **Using LESS TACK than the rule book requires will NOT be penalized.**
- Attire requirements are informal, but dressing the part will definitely look good for pictures! ☺
- Boots with a heel required if you are riding with stirrups.
- The goal here is common sense, safety and fun. Any exceptions or questions will be dealt with on an individual basis. Bring your concerns to the Show Office.

Patterns

- Extra copies of all patterns will be available at the show office and links to patterns are available on our website, www.nakedhorseshow.com.
- Dressage Tests used will be HCBC 2010 versions (Walk/Trot, Training, First Level or Second Level). Any Dressage Test can be used, inform Judge before riding your test.

Divisions

Riders cannot cross-enter multiple divisions in a single class (i.e. Equitation Experienced and Equitation Beginner). Riders ARE allowed to enter DIFFERENT divisions in different classes (Beginner Trail and Experienced Pleasure, or Reining Walk/Trot and Equitation Experienced). Riders are being asked to be honest and fair with their self-assessments!

- **Experienced** – Open to any age, experienced with natural horsemanship and/or experienced in competitions
- **Beginner** – For riders over 14 years old, not ready for Experienced
- **Junior Beginner** – For riders 13 and under, not ready Experienced
